
BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF TONTOGANY, COUNTY OF WOOD AND STATE OF OHIO:

SECTION 1. That the Village of Tontogany hereby agrees to renew a certain written agreement with the Wood County Public Defender Commission regarding their representation of indigent persons charged only under Village Ordinance(s) for the year 2018. A copy of said agreement is attached hereto and incorporated herein;

SECTION 2. That the Village Fiscal Officer shall execute any and all documentation for estimation of the total amount that will become due under the agreement with the Public Defender Commission; for certification of said sum to the Wood County Auditor; and for certification of availability of funds for the aforesaid agreement.
