Ordinance No. 850-14

Passed JULY 21, 2014

AN ORDINANCE APPOINTING A PROSECUTOR TO REPRESENT THE VILLAGE OF TONTOGANY, OHIO IN TRAFFIC AND CRIMINAL CASES; ESTABLISHING COMPENSATION THEREFORE; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

BE IT ORDAINED BY COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF TONTOGANY, COUNTY OF WOOD AND STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1: That MATTHEW L. REGER, Attorney at Law, 711 S. Dunbridge Rd., Bowling Green, OH 43402, is hereby appointed and empowered to prosecute all Tontogany traffic and criminal cases, except municipal income tax cases, for the period July 1, 2014 through June 30, 2016. He shall be compensated at the rate of \$72.00 per hour (\$80.00, less 10% discount).

Section 2: That said MATTHEW L. REGER shall have exclusive responsibility and authority for the prosecution of all Tontogany traffic and criminal cases, except municipal income tax cases, with no direction or control from the Village Solicitor.

Section 3: That said MATTHEW L. REGER shall personally provide bi-annual statistical reports to the Tontogany Village Council that detail the fines collected for cases prosecuted, with said reports presented in open meetings of council.

Section 4: That the Council hereby finds and determines that all formal actions relative to the passage of this Ordinance were taken in an open meeting of the Council and that all deliberations of the council and its committees, if any, which resulted in formal action, were taken in meetings open to the public, in full compliance with applicable legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 5: That this Ordinance constitutes an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public safety and welfare of the citizens of Tontogany for the reason that time is of the essence to continue the services of the Village Prosecutor, and shall, therefore, go into immediate effect upon passage thereof.
