

Ordinance No. 851-14

Passed JULY 21, 2014

AN ORDINANCE TO PROVIDE FOR THE COST AND EXPENSE OF PROVIDING FOR THE REMOVAL AND SPECIAL TREATMENT OF SHADE TREES FOR THE PURPOSE OF CONTROLLING BLIGHT AND DISEASE OF SAME; AND FOR PLANTING, MAINTAINING, TRIMMING AND REMOVING SHADE TREES IN AND ALONG THE STREETS AND WITHIN THE PUBLIC RIGHT OF WAY OF THE VILLAGE; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF TONTOGANY, WOOD COUNTY, OHIO:

Section 1. That the cost and expense of providing for the removal and special treatment of shade trees for the purpose of controlling the blight and disease of same; and for planting, maintaining, trimming and removing shade trees in and along the streets and within public right of way of the Village for the tax year 2015 be paid for by Special Assessment upon the lots and lands, as listed on the real estate tax duplicate excluding parcels in an exempt classification, within said Village, and that such purposes there shall be levied and assessed according to the percentage of the tax valuation of the said lots and lands a total amount of \$ 4,000.00.

Section 2. This Ordinance is deemed to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety and, therefore, shall go into immediate effect. The reason for the emergency is that it is urgently necessary to provide the funding for the removal and special treatment of shade trees for the purpose of controlling the blight and disease of same; and for planting, maintaining, trimming and removing shade trees in and along the streets and within public right of way of the Village for the safety and protection of the inhabitants of the Village of Tontogany.
