ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE INCREASE OF 2014 PERMANENT APPROPRIATIONS TO THE WATER AND ELECTRIC FUNDS; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF TONTOGANY, COUNTY OF WOOD AND STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1: That the Fiscal Officer of the Village of Tontogany, Ohio is hereby authorized to increase the 2014 permanent appropriations in the Water Fund by \$3350.00 and the Electric Fund by \$3350.00.

Section 2: That it is found and determined that all formal actions of the Council of the Village of Tontogany concerning and relating to the adoption of this ordinance were done in an open meeting of Council, and that all deliberations of Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.


Section 3: That this ordinance constitutes an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public welfare due to the need to secure replacement meter reading equipment required to continue providing utility services, and, therefore, shall go into immediate effect upon passage thereof.
