AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE VILLAGE OF TONTOGANY TO RENEW AN AGREEMENT WITH THE WOOD COUNTY PUBLIC DEFENDER COMMISSION FOR SERVICES TO REPRESENT INDIGENT PERSONS CHARGED ONLY UNDER VILLAGE ORDINANCE FOR THE YEAR 2016 AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF TONTOGANY, COUNTY OF WOOD AND STATE OF OHIO:

SECTION 1. That the Village of Tontogany hereby agrees to renew a certain written agreement with the Wood County Public Defender Commission regarding their representation of indigent persons charged only under Village Ordinance(s) for the year 2016. A copy of said agreement is attached hereto and incorporated herein;

SECTION 2. That the Village Fiscal Officer shall execute any and all documentation for estimation of the total amount that will become due under the agreement with the Public Defender Commission; for certification of said sum to the Wood County Auditor; and for certification of availability of funds for the aforesaid agreement;

SECTION 3. That this Ordinance constitutes an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, welfare and safety for the reason that the Village must continued timely to provide for indigent representation for people charged under Village ordinance only where the penalty includes the potential loss of liberty, and, therefore, shall go into immediate effect upon passage thereof.
