SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATION ORDINANCE

An Ordinance to make a supplemental appropriation for the Current Expenses and Other Expenditures of the Village of Tontogany, Ohio, during the fiscal year ending December 31, 2015.

Section 1. Be it ordained by the Council of the Village of Tontogany, State of Ohio, That, to provide for the Current Expenses and Other Expenditures for the said Village of Tontogany during the fiscal year ending December 31, 2015, the following sums be and they are hereby set aside and appropriated as follows:

Section 2. That there be appropriated from the General Fund:

Section 3. That there be appropriated from the Water Fund:

Section 4. That there be appropriated from the Electric Fund:

5301-514-190-0001	Salary – Meter Reader	\$600.00
5301-514-211-0001	Ohio PERS – Meter Reader	\$ 40.00

That this Ordinance constitutes an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of public welfare of the Village of Tontogany for proper, timely adoption proceedings are legally required to enable the effective, efficient educational utilization of property, and shall, therefore, go into immediate effect upon passage thereof.
