AN ORDINANCE RETAINING THE SERVICES OF MATTHEW REGER, ATTORNEY AT LAW, AS VILLAGE LEGAL COUNSEL AND VILLAGE PROSECUTOR; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

BE IT ORDAINED BY COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF TONTOGANY, COUNTY OF WOOD AND STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That the Village of Tontogany hereby retains the services of Matthew Reger, Attorney at Law, 711 S. Dunbridge Road, Bowling Green, Ohio, to serve the Village as its legal counsel and prosecutor, as more specifically enumerated herein for the period July 1, 2016 through December 31, 2016.

Section 2. That the terms and conditions of such services are as follows:

The Village agrees to compensate Matthew Reger for legal services the sum of One Hundred Twenty-five Dollars (\$125.00) per hour for all hours billed during period July 1, 2016 and December 31, 2016.

All legal services not rendered at council meetings shall be given at the law office of Matthew Reger during regular office hours, or at such other times and place as mutually agreed upon. Attorney Reger shall also serve as Village Prosecutor for the prosecution of any and all criminal/traffic proceedings involving the Village of Tontogany, as provided for by other legislation.

Section 3. That the council hereby finds and determines that all formal actions relative to the adoption of this Ordinance were taken in an open meeting of the Council and that all deliberations of this Council and its committees, if any, which resulted in formal action, were taken in meetings open to the public, in full compliance with applicable legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 4. That this Ordinance shall be effective for all work performed on and after July 1, 2016.

Section 5. That this Ordinance constitutes an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public safety and welfare of the citizens of Tontogany for the reason that time is of the essence to continue the services of the Village Solicitor and Prosecutor, and shall, therefore, go into immediate effect upon passage thereof.
