

ORDINANCE NO. 561-93

AN ORDINANCE TO AUTHORIZE THE BOARD OF PUBLIC AFFAIRS, VILLAGE OF TONTOGANY, WOOD COUNTY, OHIO, TO CERTIFY TO THE COUNTY AUDITOR DELINQUENT UTILITY ACCOUNTS TO BE COLLECTED BY SPECIAL ASSESSMENT

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF TONTOGANY, WOOD COUNTY, OHIO:

Section 1. That the Board of Public Affairs is hereby authorized to certify to the Wood County Auditor the collection by Special Assessment upon the parcels of property owners, as listed on the real estate tax duplicate, of customer water and electric accounts ascertained to be delinquent by the Board.

Section 2. That the Board of Public Affairs will not resort to certifying to the Wood County Auditor any accounts as delinquent until after reasonable collection procedures have failed.

Section 3. This Ordinance is deemed to be an emergency measure necessary for immediate fiscal responsibility and good stewardship of public monetary funds.
