

ORDINANCE NO.: 830-12


ORDINANCE TO PROVIDE FOR THE COST AND EXPENSE OF THE
LIGHTING OF THE STREETS, ALLEYS, WAYS, AND OTHER
PUBLIC PLACES AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF TONTOGANY,
WOOD COUNTY, OHIO:


Section 1. That the cost and expense of the lighting of the streets, alleys, ways, and other public places in the Village of Tontogany and the furnishing of electrical energy therefore, for the tax year 2013 be paid for by Special Assessment upon the lots and lands, as listed on the real estate tax duplicate excluding parcels in an exempt classification, within said Village, and that such purposes there shall be levied and assessed according to the percentage of the tax valuation of the said lots and lands a total amount of \$4,000.00.

Section 2. This Ordinance is deemed to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety and, therefore, shall go into immediate effect. The reason for the emergency is that it is urgently necessary to provide the funding to pay for the lighting of the streets, alleys, ways, and other public places in the Village for the safety and protection of the inhabitants of the Village of Tontogany.
