ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 807-10 REGARDING COMPENSATION FOR COUNCIL MEMBERS IN AMOUNT AND ENTITLEMENT; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

BE IT ORDAINED BY COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF TONTOGANY, COUNTY OF WOOD AND STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That Section 2 of Ordinance No. 807-10, which currently reads:

**Section 2. That this compensation amount shall be effective for terms of office commencing on and after January 1, 2012 pursuant to Ohio Revised Code Section 731.13.**

is hereby amended to read:


**Section 2. That this compensation amount shall be effective for terms of office commencing on and after January 1, 2012 pursuant to Ohio Revised Code Section 731.13, and be conditional upon a member attending at least one (1) Council meeting monthly or being excused for nonattendance by Council.**

Section 2. That all ordinances inconsistent herewith are repealed.

Section 3. That this Ordinance constitutes an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public safety and welfare of the citizens of Tontogany for the reason that time is of the essence to continue the services and compensation of Village Council, and shall, therefore, go into immediate effect upon passage thereof.


