

ORDINANCE NO. 867-16

PASSED APRIL 4, 2016

AN ORDINANCE TO APPOINT MEMBERS TO THE BOARD OF TAX REVIEW

WHEREAS, the Village of Tontogany Council recently adopted a tax ordinance, Ordinance No. 861-15, based upon the Ohio General Assembly’s enactment of H. B. 5 in December 2014, mandating that municipal income tax codes be amended by January 1, 2016 such that any income or withholding tax is “levied in accordance with the provisions and limitations specified in Chapter 718;” and

WHEREAS, it is required in Section 23 of Ordinance No. 861-15 that a Board of Tax Review shall be appointed by council and the mayor; and

WHEREAS, Section 23 provides that two (2) members of the board be appointed by council and one (1) member be appointed by the mayor; and

WHEREAS, the mayor has appointed John K. Heckerman to the Board of Tax Review; and

WHEREAS, village council has determined the two names it wishes to appoint to the Board of Tax Review;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY/VILLAGE OF TONTOGANY, COUNTY OF WOOD, STATE OF OHIO, THAT:

Section 1. That pursuant to Tontogany Ordinance No. 861-15 the village council appoints Peggy L. Limes and Kimberly S. Head as members of the Board of Tax Review for a two year term that is renewable; and

Section 2. That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure and shall take effect and be in force immediately from and after its passage. An emergency exists because the Village Tax Ordinance took effect on January 1, 2016 and there is a need to have a Board of Tax Review in place.
