

Ordinance No. 889-18

Passed AUGUST 20, 2018

AN ORDINANCE TO PROVIDE FOR THE COST AND EXPENSE OF PROVIDING FOR THE REMOVAL AND SPECIAL TREATMENT OF SHADE TREES FOR THE PURPOSE OF CONTROLLING BLIGHT AND DISEASE OF SAME; AND FOR PLANTING, MAINTAINING, TRIMMING AND REMOVING SHADE TREES IN AND ALONG THE STREETS AND WITHIN THE PUBLIC RIGHT OF WAY OF THE VILLAGE

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF TONTOGANY, WOOD COUNTY, OHIO:

Section 1. That the cost and expense of providing for the removal and special treatment of shade trees for the purpose of controlling the blight and disease of same; and for planting, maintaining, trimming and removing shade trees in and along the streets and within public right of way of the Village for the tax year 2019 be paid for by Special Assessment upon the lots and lands, as listed on the real estate tax duplicate excluding parcels in an exempt classification, within said Village, and that for such purposes there shall be levied and assessed according to the percentage of the tax valuation of the said lots and lands a total amount of \$5,000.00.
