A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR OF THE VILLAGE OF TONTOGANY TO PREPARE AND SUBMIT AN APPLICATION TO PARTICIPATE IN THE OHIO PUBLIC WORKS COMMISSION STATE CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT AND / OR LOCAL TRANSPORTATION IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM(S) AND TO EXECUTE CONTRACTS AS REQUIRED; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the State Capital Improvement Program and the Local Transportation Improvement Program both provide financial assistance to political subdivisions for capital improvements to public infrastructure, and

WHEREAS, the Village of Tontogany is planning to make capital improvements to the VILLAGES OF HASKINS, HOYTVILLE, TONTOGANY AND WESTON AND THE TOWNSHIP OF JACKSON ROADWAY PROJECT, and

WHEREAS, the infrastructure improvement herein above described is considered to be a priority need for the community and is a qualified project under the OPWC programs,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE VILLAGE OF TONTOGANY, COUNTY OF WOOD AND STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1: That the Mayor of the Village of Tontogany is hereby authorized to apply to the OPWC for funds as described above.

Section 2: That the Mayor of the Village of Tontogany is hereby authorized to enter into any agreements as may be necessary and appropriate for obtaining this financial assistance.

Section 3: That this resolution constitutes an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public welfare due to the need to repair village streets, and, therefore, shall go into immediate effect upon passage thereof.
