A RESOLUTION ADOPTING THE WOOD COUNTY HAZARD MITIGATION PLAN

WHEREAS, the Village of Tontogany is a statutory village located in Wood County, Ohio and

WHEREAS, the Village of Tontogany has powers of local self-government, pursuant to Article XVIII, Section 3 of the Ohio Constitution, and the Ohio Revised Code, and

WHEREAS, the Wood County Emergency Management Agency, a department of the Wood County Board of County Commissioners, has developed a Hazard Mitigation Plan to reduce or eliminate long-term risks to the people and property in Wood County from the impacts of future hazards and disasters, and has presented the plan to the Federal Emergency Management Agency, (FEMA), via the Ohio Emergency Management Agency, (Ohio EMA), and

WHEREAS, FEMA and Ohio EMA have approved said Hazard Mitigation Plan, and

WHEREAS, the Wood County Board of County Commissioners has adopted said plan, and

WHEREAS, it is the desire of the Village of Tontogany to adopt the Wood County Hazard Mitigation Plan.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF TONTOGANY, WOOD COUNTY, STATE OF OHIO, THAT:

- 1. The Wood County Hazard Mitigation Plan, as approved by FEMA and Ohio EMA, and as adopted by the Wood County Board of County Commissioners, is hereby adopted.
- 2. The Village Fiscal Officer is hereby directed to publish this Resolution after its passage in accordance with Ohio law and Village rules.
- 3. It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any other committees that results in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
