

**VILLAGE OF TONTOGANY, WOOD COUNTY, OHIO**  
**ORDINANCE 897-18**

**AN ORDINANCE MAKING SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATIONS  
FOR THE FISCAL YEAR ENDING DECEMBER 31, 2018,  
AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY**

**WHEREAS**, the Village of Tontogany is a statutory village in Wood County, Ohio, and

**WHEREAS**, the Village has approved appropriations for the 2018 fiscal year, and

**WHEREAS**, it has been found that certain appropriations accounts for the 2018 fiscal year require additional revenues to allow for the proper procedures for the expenditure of money to be followed.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of the Village of Tontogany, that:

1. That Ordinance 884-17, the appropriation ordinance for the fiscal year 2018, shall be amended to provide for the following appropriations in the accounts as set forth below.

The amounts set forth above as amended appropriations are in lieu of or in substitution for the amounts, if any, appropriated to these accounts by the permanent appropriations ordinance adopted for the fiscal year ending December 31, 2018.


2. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, safety and welfare of the Village and its residents for the reason that the above accounts must have sufficient balances for the proper expenditure procedures to be filed.

It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any other committees that results in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements including Section 121.22 of the Revised Code of Ohio.


