

VILLAGE OF TONTOGANY, WOOD COUNTY, OHIO
ORDINANCE 906-19

AN ORDINANCE MAKING SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATIONS
FOR THE FISCAL YEAR ENDING DECEMBER 31, 2019,
AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the Village of Tontogany is a statutory village in Wood County, Ohio, and

WHEREAS, the Village has approved appropriations for the 2019 fiscal year, and

WHEREAS, it has been found that certain appropriations accounts for the 2019 fiscal year require additional revenues to allow for the proper procedures for the expenditure of money to be followed.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Tontogany, that:

1. That Ordinance 898-18, the appropriation ordinance for the fiscal year 2019, shall be amended to provide for the following appropriations in the accounts as set forth below.


This represents total additional appropriations of \$75,000. The amounts set forth above as amended appropriations are in lieu of or in substitution for the amounts, if any, appropriated to these accounts by the permanent appropriations ordinance adopted for the fiscal year ending December 31, 2019.

2. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, safety and welfare of the Village and its residents for the reason that the above accounts must have sufficient balances for the proper expenditure procedures to be filed in 2019.


