

ORDINANCE NO. 907-19
ORDINANCE INCREASING THE SALARY OF THE
VILLAGE FISCAL OFFICER AND ZONING INSPECTOR, AND DECLARING
AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the Village of Tontogany is a statutory village located in Wood County, Ohio, and

WHEREAS, the Village has created the positions of Fiscal Officer and Zoning Inspector, and salaries for each have previously been established by the Council, and

WHEREAS, the Ohio Constitution, Article XVIII, Section 3, gives the Village powers of local self-government which include, but are not limited to, setting the salaries of Village employees.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Tontogany, County of Wood, State of Ohio, that:

Section 1. The salary of the Village Fiscal Officer shall be increased from \$1,550 per month to \$1,750 per month, effective January 1, 2020.

Section 2. The salary of the Village Zoning Inspector shall be increased from \$100 per month to \$125 per month, effective January 1, 2020.

Section 3. It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any other committees that results in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements including Section 121.22 of the Revised Code of Ohio.

Section 4. This measure is an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the health, safety and welfare of the village and its residents for the reason that the council must adopt an annual budget by year-end and in order to meet that deadline, village salaries must be established in advance of the new year.
