AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING SCHOOL ZONE TRAFFIC REGULATIONS

WHEREAS, the Village of Tontogany is a statutory village located in Wood County, Ohio and

WHEREAS, the Village of Tontogany has powers of local self-government pursuant to Article XVIII, Section 3 of the Ohio Constitution, and the power to regulate local traffic within the Village pursuant to R.C. chapters 4511 and 4513, and

WHEREAS, the Village of Tontogany desires to protect the safety of vehicular and pedestrian traffic and prevent hazards and obstructions to the normal movement of such traffic in the area of Otsego Schools.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF TONTOGANY, WOOD COUNTY OHIO, THAT:

<u>SECTION 1</u> The Council of the Village of Tontogany hereby finds that the protection of children traveling to and from Otsego Schools is of the utmost importance, and hereby accepts replacement signs alerting vehicular traffic of the Otsego School zone and crosswalk as part of the Otsego Schools solar panel project.

<u>SECTION 2.</u> The signs alerting vehicular traffic of the existence of Otsego Schools and the school pedestrian zone, previously established and installed by this Council and/or Otsego Schools, including lighted "School Zone" signs, school cross-walk signs, and "End School Zone" signs, require replacement.

<u>SECTION 3.</u> This Council hereby authorizes Otsego Schools to install replacement school zone signs as set forth herein at section 2.

<u>SECTION 4.</u> The aforementioned signs shall comply with the Ohio Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices, published by the Ohio Department of Transportation, and shall be installed according to such Manual.

<u>SECTION 9.</u> It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such a formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements including Section 121.22 of the Revised Code of Ohio.
