

VILLAGE OF TONTOGANY, WOOD COUNTY, OHIO
ORDINANCE 918-20

**AN ORDINANCE MAKING SUPPLEMENTAL CARES ACT APPROPRIATIONS
FOR THE FISCAL YEAR ENDING DECEMBER 31, 2020,
AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY**

WHEREAS, the Village of Tontogany is a statutory village located in Wood County, Ohio, and

WHEREAS, Village Council passed Resolution 740-05 authorizing the transfer of money from one line account to another, within the same fund, as necessary, and

WHEREAS, the Village has approved appropriations for the 2020 fiscal year, and

WHEREAS, the Village has received certain moneys owing to the CARES Act, in the amount of \$4,373.93, which was deposited into a newly created special revenue fund dedicated to such moneys, pursuant to Ord. 916-20, and

WHEREAS, it has been found that certain appropriation accounts for the 2020 fiscal year require additional revenues to allow for the proper expenditure of CARES Act money.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Tontogany, that:

1. That Ordinance 908-19, the appropriation ordinance for the fiscal year 2020, shall be amended to provide for the following appropriations in the accounts as set forth below:

From Coronavirus Relief Special Revenue Fund, \$4,373.93, to

Account number 2151-290-399 Other Contractual Services, \$2,187.00

Account number 2151-290-400 Supplies and Materials, \$ 2,186.93

The appropriations set forth above are in addition to the amounts, if any, appropriated to these accounts by the permanent appropriations ordinance adopted for the fiscal year ending December 31, 2020.

2. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, safety and welfare of the Village and its residents for the reason that the above accounts must have sufficient balances for the proper expenditure procedures to be filed in 2020, and the CARES Act money must be spent forthwith. Failure to promptly spend the funds will result in the required return of the unspent money.
3. It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any other committees that results in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
