

ORDINANCE NO. 951-22

VILLAGE OF TONTOGANY, WOOD COUNTY, OHIO

ORDINANCE TO ALLOW SALE OF ALCOHOL IN THE VILLAGE

**WHEREAS**, the Village of Tontogany is a statutory village located in Wood County, Ohio, and

**WHEREAS**, Ohio Constitution Section XVIII, Article 3, gives the Village powers of local self government, and

**WHEREAS**, the Village of Tontogany desires to promote local business within the village, and

**WHEREAS**, several businesses in the Village of Tontogany will benefit from the ability to sell alcohol.


**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED**, by the Council of the Village of Tontogany, Wood County, Ohio that:

**Section 1:** To the extent that any prior ordinance which prohibited the sale of alcohol within Village limits was passed by the Council of the Village of Tontogany, that ordinance is hereby revoked.

**Section 2:** The Village of Tontogany intends, to the extent allowable by Ohio Law, to permit the sale of alcohol within the Village on all days of the year.


