ORDINANCE MAKING SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATIONS FOR THE FISCAL YEAR ENDING DECEMBER 31, 2022, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the Village of Tontogany is a statutory village located in Wood County, Ohio, and

WHEREAS, the Village of Tontogany has powers of local self-government pursuant to Ohio Constitution Article XVIII, Section 3, and the Ohio Revised Code, and

WHEREAS, the Village Council adopted permanent appropriations for fiscal year ending December 31, 2022, by Ordinance No. 943-21, and

WHEREAS, Council has determined that Ordinance No. 943.21, the permanent appropriations ordinance for the fiscal year ending December 31, 2022, shall be amended to provide for receipt of certain federal funds.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of the Village of Tontogany, Wood County, Ohio, that:

Section 1:

In order to provide for receipt of funds received from the American Rescue Act Fund, the Office the Budget and Management, and for current expenses and other expenditures of the village for fiscal year ending December 31, 2022, Ordinance No.943-21, the permanent appropriations ordinance for the fiscal year ending December 31, 2022, shall be amended to provide for the following appropriations in the accounts and amounts as set forth below:
