ORDINANCE NO. 970-24

AN ORDINANCE MAKING SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATIONS
FOR THE FISCAL YEAR ENDING DECEMBER 31, 2024

WHEREAS, the Village of Tontogany is a statutory village located in Wood County, Ohio, and

WHEREAS, the Village has approved appropriations for the 2024 fiscal year, and

WHEREAS, it has been found that the Suburban grant account requires additional appropriations to allow for the proper procedures for the expenditure of money to be followed.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of the Village of Tontogany, Wood County, Ohio, that:

Section 1: Ordinance 966-23, the appropriation ordinance for the fiscal year 2024, shall be amended to provide for the following appropriations in the account as set forth below:


