## VILLAGE OF TONTOGANY, WOOD COUNTY, OHIO ORDINANCE NO. 976-24

AN ORDINANCE TO PROVIDE FOR THE COST AND EXPENSE OF THE LIGHTING OF THE STREETS, ALLEYS, WAYS, AND OTHER PUBLIC PLACES OF THE VILLAGE OF TONTOGANY

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF TONTOGANY, WOOD COUNTY, OHIO:

**Section 1.** That the cost and expense of the lighting of the streets, alleys, ways, and other public places in the Village of Tontogany and the furnishing of electrical energy therefor, for the tax year 2025 be paid for by Special Assessment upon the lots and lands, as listed on the real estate tax duplicate excluding parcels in an exempt classification, within said Village, and that for such purposes there shall be levied and assessed according to the percentage of the tax valuation of the said lots and lands a total amount of \$4,000.00.

**Section 2.** It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any other committees that results in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
